- Bernie's Book Bank is named for Dr. Bernard P. Floriani, the father of Founder and Chief Advancement Officer, Brian Floriani.
- Bernie was a self-made man the son of a coal miner who grew up in a house without running water until he went to college on a basketball scholarship who achieved a BA, MA, and Doctorate's degree in reading education.
- The sudden death of his father, Bernie, inspired him to do something different with his life. He now understood the importance of what his father knew — that reading is the single most important skill a child needs in order to contribute and function competently within our society.
- Brian began working as a reading paraprofessional for Shiloh Park Elementary in Zion, Illinois. He spent every day tutoring struggling readers.
- He now understood the importance of what his father knew that **reading is the single most im**portant skill a child needs in order to contribute and function competently within our society.
- Furthermore, he realized that all of these children probably could have been "reading ready" if they had been provided access to books at home before entering Kindergarten.
- In December 2009, Bernie's Book Bank was founded in Brian's garage as this was where he began sourcing and redistributing books to under-served children.
- In 2021 they have distributed 20 MILLION books distributed since 2009 to school districts in the Chicagoland area. They invite you to be a volunteer!


