(The IPI's sole goal is to get members to quit their union and to make retiree organizations as weak as possible by using mailers, phone calls, videos, emails, and even home visits by talking down the IL Education Association, the IL Federation of Teachers, and the state pension system. They don't care that the TRS is protected by the State Constitution and that public educators worked for 20-35 years to build a secure pension and retirement program. It wants to destroy the IRTA and any local retirement association like [KRTA] which is the only source of organized power for retirees.

Why is the IPI so committed to weakening public employee unions? Because they want to abolish public employee pensions. They know that strong unions are the chief force standing in their way. If they can weaken us, their odds of ending pensions would go away.

After this November election is completed, the IRTA, the TRS, and local organizations will once again need to "stand guard" and protect our pensions and insurance policies.
