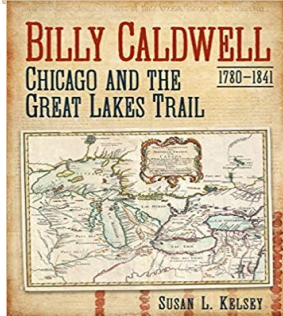
Following Chief Sauganash - Susan Kelsey

It all started one day in 1993, when Susan Kelsey was walking around the Sauganash neighborhood on the Northwest Side of Chicago, where she then lived. "There's a plaque in the neighborhood," Kelsey, now of Lake Forest, said. "It was on the edge of the Billy Caldwell reservation. I started wondering who this guy was and why this neighborhood was called Sauganash." Her research has culminated in "Following Chief Sauganash,"

He was born March 17, 1780 to Mohawk mother and Irish father near Ft. Niagara (NY); educated by Jesuits; became a fur trader arriving in "Chicago," (Fort Dearborn), in 1812; because of his personality and his ability to speak English, French and Algonquin, he helped to negotiate several treaties in 1820 and the Treaty of Chicago in 1833; he may have travelled through "Lake Forest," either along "Green Bay Road" or by paddling up Lake Michigan on his way to "Little Fort," (Waukegan), a small trading post; started St. Mary of the Assumption in Chicago, before leaving for Iowa with his wife and other families, establishing a community there.

HOW TO PREVENT EMAILS FROM GOING TO SPAM

To ensure that you receive VoterVoice emails and Good Dog News emails in your inbox instead of in your spam or junk mail, do the following:

Add irta@irtaonline.org and Good Dog eNews info@irtaonline.org to the "From" address to your contacts or list of safe senders.

To complete this with a :

Gmail account:

- Go to Google Contacts
- At the top left, click Create Contact
- Enter the contact's information
- Click SAVE

Yahoo account:

- Click the Spam folder. If you don't see the spam folder, click MORE below the "Sent" folder.
- Select the email
- Click it's not spam to move the message into your inbox, and future message from this sender should be delivered to your inbox.

Comcast account:

- Check your spam box.
 - Select the email
 - Click the folder with the right facing arrow at the top.
 - Move the email to the inbox.

Regardless of any changes you make, trying to move an email from spam to inbox, you should check your spam and junk boxes regularly, as some IRTA emails may slip through. All the big email platforms are constantly changing their algorithms to fight spam; so an email that may get through one time, may be filtered the next. It's just impossible to know what they are doing.
